WHERE: Camp Laughery Group Camp at Versailles State Park, IN

WHEN: April 26th- April 29th, 2019. Check in: Fri after 3pm; Check out: Mon by 11am.

LODGING COST:

\$65/ family, \$80 after Apr 8th (whole cabin) – Limited, register early!

\$25/individual, \$40 after Apr 8th (single bed, in a male or female group cabin)

- This is a camp out for adults and families, including children, through Eagle Eye Community on Mission. Participants are welcome to come and go, as it works for your schedule and needs.
- Parents are responsible for all children under 18.
- Activities are optional, but participation is welcomed!
- We need everyone's help with kitchen & camp clean-up. Please come with a willing spirit!

SAMPLE FOOD MENU:

Breakfasts – coffee/tea, scrambled eggs, oatmeal, fruit

Lunches – simple packable lunches for hiking (i.e. pb&j, fruit, chips, dessert)

Dinners – group potluck (bring a dish to share)

SAMPLE SCHEDULE:

(8am) Morning Prayer (lauds)

(8:30am) Breakfast

(9:15am) Clean-up Groups/Pack Lunches

(10am) Morning Activity: separate into optional hiking groups (i.e. Adventurous, Leisurely, YA hiking group, etc.) Lunch on trail.

(3pm) Mid-Afternoon – all-camp field games (i.e. Capture the Flag, Kickball, Ultimate, etc.)

(5pm) Evening prayer (vespers)

(6pm) Potluck Dinner

(6:45pm) Clean up Groups/Campfire Prep

(7:30pm) Evening Program – i.e Campfire, Square Dance, Euchre tournament, etc.

(Possible: Mass, Adoration, Confession, Spiritual Direction... tbd upon priest availability)

CAMPGROUND DETAILS:

- Entrance fee is \$7 per vehicle for in-state plates, and \$9 per vehicle for out-of-state plates. When staying overnight, you will be required to pay the entrance fee the first time you enter, and your receipt will serve as your in/out pass the remainder of your stay. (Please consider carpooling!)
- The Industrial Kitchen is equipped with large industrial stove, oven, walk-in refrigerator, and a large freezer. Kitchen contains two large sinks with hot & cold water, garbage disposal. A large group grill is provided outside. Electricity is available as well.
- Vehicles permitted in parking areas only, Cannot drive to cabins. No campers or tents.
- Camp Laughery Group Camp consists of: 12 camper cabins, 1 recreation hall, 1 industrial kitchen with dining hall, large firepit with stage and amphitheater seating, huge grassy/woody area.
- No firearms, weapons, etc.
- Furniture is not to be used for outdoor activities.

CABIN DETAILS:



- There are 12 HUGE cabins, with 10 beds in each. There is plenty of room for a pack n play, etc. (Several of these cabins will be set aside for entire families to reserve.)
- The cabins DO have electricity, but NO heat or air conditioning.
- We MAY bring fans, but no heaters, no air conditioners.
- Flush toilets/shower facilities are in a separate building.
- Must bring own pillows/bedding.
- Camp Laughery is a self-clean facility. We must leave the cabins & facilities as clean or better than when we arrived. Please realize we need everyone's help to make this a simple task!!
- All cabins must be swept (& mopped if necessary), before cabin check-out.
- Please bring extra cleaning supplies, if you are able, so there will be plenty for all to help – cleaning spray, brooms, mop, rags, etc.

PACKING LIST:

- Raincoat/winter coat/layers – activities will go on rain or shine
- Hat/gloves/warm socks/long johns/hand or foot warmers – just in case!
- Pillow/bedding

- Cleaning supplies – to help with final cleanup
- Hiking shoes
- Towel/washcloth/shower shoes
- Toiletries
- Clothes/pj's
- Flashlight
- Camp chair – if you prefer (wooden benches provided)
- Cell Phone – If possible, please download Ibreviary for the Liturgy of the Hours
- Food Items – per your meal plan selection
- Need special cooking items for your potluck dishes? (i.e. crockpot, casserole dish, etc)
- Bug spray/sunscreen?
- Fan for cabin?
- Balls, frisbee disc, outdoor toys, nerf items, etc.
- Board games, card games, etc.
- Wagon? (for hauling items to cabins)
- Instruments? Props? (for campfire songs, skits, or entertainment)
- Team Leaders: matches, fire starters, first aid kit
